1. Changes to Worship Service

Thank you for your continued support and cooperation during this period of change.

E-bulletins: Since early July, we have been using only e-bulletins and will continue with this digital format to support a smooth adjustment for all attendees. This digital-only format will remain our standard throughout our time at Suntec over the next two years.

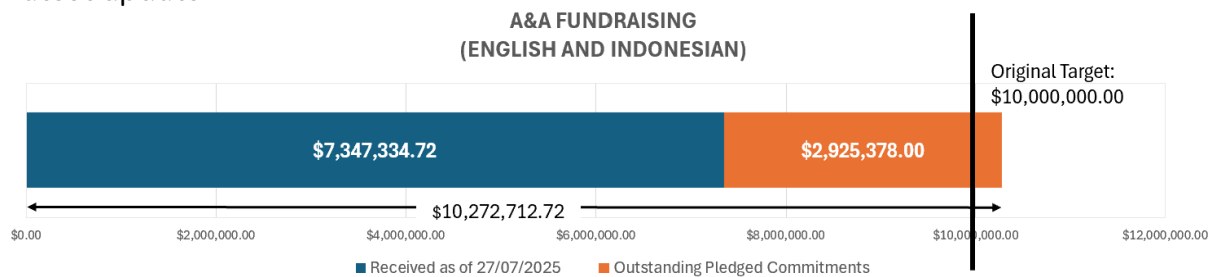
Suntec Worship Location - We're pleased to confirm the worship service timings at Suntec:

4. Technical Updates

The MDT (Messrs Formwerkz Architects LLP) is now in the process of making submissions of our development plan to the various authorities and holding discussions with them as to the changes that need to be made. They have also completed the pre-qualification process for potential contractors and are calling for main contractor tender submissions.
