Applying the Principle of *Soli Deo Gloria* to Life

To live with *Soli Deo Gloria* (Latin for "glory to God alone") means directing every aspect of life — work, relationships, and actions — to honour God rather than seeking personal recognition. It is a Protestant Reformation doctrine asserting that salvation and all of life are for God's praise, shifting focus from human achievement to God's glory.

Our talk focuses on the key aspect of holistic worship. This idea implies that everyday activities — such as eating or working — are opportunities to honour God, not just Sunday worship. This translates to purposeful living, whereby one's life is transformed into a purposeful act for God and the gospel.

The talk will conclude with examples of how to live with integrity, serving others in Christ's name, and — as composer J.S. Bach did — dedicating one's talents to God rather than personal fame. This doctrine of *Soli Deo Gloria* serves as a reminder that without God, we can do nothing, and therefore everything should ultimately point back to Him.

PRESBYTERIAN PRIMARY SCHOOLS — P1 PHASE 2B REGISTRATION

ORPC members who wish to register their children in Kuo Chuan Presbyterian Primary School (Bishan) or Pei Hwa Presbyterian Primary School (Bukit Timah) at Phase 2B for admission to Primary One in January 2027 are to **request for the Letter of Eligibility (“Form B”) from the church office before 4 May 2026 (Monday)**, via email to orpcenglish@orpc.org.sg stating (a) full names of both parents of the child, (b) at least one contact number, (c) which ministry in ORPC that parent(s) is/are serving and (d) from when parent(s) has/have been serving.

The eligibility for *priority* in P1 registration under Phase 2B is guided by the following conditions:

1. Child is either a Singapore Citizen or a Singapore Permanent Resident.
2. At least one parent being an active communicant member of ORPC. An ‘active communicant member’ here refers to a baptised church member who has volunteered at least one year of service to ORPC i.e. has been serving on or before 1 June 2025.
3. If the number of applicants exceed the number of vacancies in the school, places will be balloted according to the following order of priority:
 - a) Singapore Citizens will be given priority over Singapore Permanent Residents, before home-school distance is considered.
 - b) Children living within 1km of the school.
 - c) Children living between 1km and 2km of the school.
 - d) Children living outside 2km of the school.

- **Parents are to submit hardcopies of the following to the church office, latest, by 4 May 2026 (Monday):**
 - i. ‘Letter of Eligibility’ (“Form B”) with Section A completed;
 - ii. Photocopy of Child’s birth certificate/Citizenship certificate/PR document;
 - iii. Photocopy of both parents’ NRIC
 - iv. Photocopy of Child’s immunisation certificate.
- The Letter of Eligibility issued by the Church gives the applicant priority in registration in an earlier Phase, namely Phase 2B, but does not guarantee a place in the school.

- **Important:** Parents will still need to complete an online registration (MOE’s) under Phase 2B national registration exercise in July 2026. Do watch out for MOE’s registration dates and the documents that would be required.
