The Wisest Fool

Who is the wisest man in the Old Testament? While many candidates come to mind, King Solomon must rank as a strong contender.

When he began his reign as king of Israel, he was granted any wish by God. Instead of asking for a long life or the demise of his enemies, he asked for wisdom to rule his people. God was very pleased with his request as it clearly reflected Solomon's maturity. And Solomon went on to display great wisdom and was the ancient version of the "guru". Even the Queen of Sheba came to Solomon to learn from him. God also blessed Solomon with riches and power. Solomon was also the king who had the First Temple built. He was credited with writing many passages in the Book of Proverbs and was the likely author of the book of Ecclesiastes.

But sadly, the wise king became a foolish one. His penchant for building lavish monuments imposed onerous taxation on his people and made their lives miserable. However, the main cause of Solomon's downfall was his love for foreign women. They were from nations which the Lord had told the Israelites not to intermarry with because they would influence the Israelites to worship their gods. (1 Kings 11:1-2)

Solomon had seven hundred wives of royal birth and three hundred concubines. Tragically, his wives led him astray. As Solomon grew old, his wives influenced him to worship other gods. He committed evil and failed to follow the Lord completely. (1 Kings 11:3-4)

In the end as punishment, God decried that after Solomon's death, the kingdom would be split in two. Solomon did not practise the wisdom that God had given him. The wisest king became a foolish one. How did that happen?

Solomon fell because he was snared by lust and worldly pleasures. God instructed him not to have foreign wives and concubines. He refused to listen. Solomon took his eyes off God and was lured away from God by his sinful desires. He had lost his love for God.

Solomon's downfall can happen to anyone. We are often tempted by lust and worldly pleasures. How then can we resist them?

We must continually focus on deepening our relationship with God. How do we do this? The answer is known to most of us. It is by diligently studying His Word, praying, being part of a Christian community, etc.

However, before we begin answering the above question, we must first ask ourselves a fundamental question, which is, "How much are we willing to sacrifice in order to know God deeply?"

BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF LOVE & GRACE

Of the many biblical themes on God, the standouts must include love and grace. However, the God of the Bible is not an impersonal abstraction. The living God is the God of love and grace. But what do such terms mean? The Bible doesn't just define these big ideas, but they are embodied in stories as well as in direct affirmations. In particular, it is Jesus Christ and his story that provide the lens through which to view what the big ideas are about.

The Extraordinary Congregational Meeting ("ECM") to re-elect our Senior Minister and Moderator, Rev Dr Clive Chin and Associate Minister, Rev Dr Edward Goh will be held by way of electronic means on Sunday, 2 Oct 2022 after the Morning Worship Service (at approx. 10.10am). The re-appointment will be for a period of 4-years with Rev Clive on a 2+2years arrangement. Both are with effect from 12 January 2023.

ORPC Session Clerk, Alimin Lie will chair and conduct the proceedings of the ECM.

The ECM will be conducted by way of electronic means as provided by the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Charities, Co-operative Societies and Mutual Benefit Organisations) Order 2020¹.

This means that members of ORPC may participate in the ECM by:

- · downloading the proxy form on orpc.sg website; and
- appointing the Chairman of the ECM as proxy to attend and vote on their behalf at the ECM.

All members are encouraged to vote by proxy through email. There will be no in-person voting at the ECM. All votes will be registered and tallied by the ORPC English Congregation Executive, Ms Yong Ping Ping, and will be treated as confidential. Two (2) representatives from English Presbytery will be present to supervise and witness the process. The Chairman of the ECM will be informed of the final tally of the votes, which will be announced at the ECM.

NOMINATION & ELECTION OF ELDERS AND DEACONS

Session is calling for ECM - Election of Elders and Deacons to be held on **Sunday, 13 November 2022**. Those elected will serve a three-year term from 1 January 2023.

ORPC members are entitled to nominate other ORPC members who have been serving faithfully in ORPC and demonstrated leadership qualities, for election as Elders or Deacons.

The closing date for nominations is **Sunday**, **2 October 2022**.

Session will interview all candidates with their spouses (if any). Those who qualify and are deemed to be suitable nominees will be recommended and announced to the congregation on three Sundays (23, 30 Oct and 6 Nov 2022) prior to the election date.

To be duly elected, candidates must receive at least (a) two-thirds of the votes cast for Elders and (b) half of the votes cast for Deacons.

WHAT DO ELDERS AND DEACONS DO?

Elders and Deacons are voluntary office bearers in the Congregation. They join the pastoral staff in pastoral leadership and oversight, oversee the management of ORPC, assist in the administration of ORPC and in all matters concerning the building-up and growth of ORPC.

Elders serve primarily in Session and may also be appointed to the Board of Management (BoM). Session is the final decision-making body in ORPC and has particular responsibility for the spiritual mission and care of ORPC.

Deacons serve in the BoM and have particular responsibility for the physical care of God's people and for managing the material resources of ORPC to serve its spiritual mission.

WHO CAN BE NOMINATED AND ELECTED?

- Elders and Deacons must meet the biblical qualifications according to 1 Timothy 3:1-13 and Titus 1:6-9.
- Nominees must be communicant members of ORPC for more than three years.
- All nominees are expected to have served in at least one area of ministry in ORPC for a minimum period of one year prior to being nominated.
- Elders must have served for at least one term of three years as a Deacon.
- Spouses of Elders and Deacons must also be communicant members of ORPC.
 Divorcees and those with previously-divorced spouses do not qualify for nomination.

- Elders and Deacons must assent to the basic creeds and confessions of the Presbyterian Church, the Apostles' Creed, the Westminster Confession of Faith, the Constitution of the Synod of the Presbyterian Church in Singapore and the Constitution of ORPC.
- Elders and Deacons must attend regular Session/BoM meetings, congregational monthly prayer meetings, ministry/committee meetings as assigned, leaders' retreats, annual and extraordinary congregational meetings. They must also share in pastoral visitation and undertake other duties relevant to their office and other assigned responsibilities as decided from time to time.

HOW TO NOMINATE?


Elders and Deacons must be proposed and seconded by other communicant members of ORPC.

A member who wants to nominate another member should first check the eligibility of that other member (please see above) before making any nomination.

The proposer needs a seconder for the nomination. After both the proposer and the seconder have signed the nomination form, the nominee must sign the form to confirm his/her consent to the nomination.
