A New Identity and Mission (1 Peter 2:9)

This is a story about Rabbi Akiva, a renowned and revered Jewish rabbi of the first century. One late afternoon, Rabbi Akiva was on his way home to Capernaum. As he walked, he was also meditating and reciting the Scriptures. He was so focused that he didn't realize that he had taken a wrong turn. Suddenly he found himself standing in front of the Roman fortress gate and a loud voice shouted, "Who are you? What are you doing here?" Rabbi Akiva was startled and could barely respond. Again the guard called out, "Who are you? What are you doing here?" After Rabbi Akiva gathered his thoughts, he shouted back: "How much do you get paid to ask me these questions?" The guard was now confused as to why this stranger would ask such a question in response. After a few moments of silence, he said, "Two drachma per week!" (a drachma was worth about a day's wage.) Then Rabbi Akiva, with intense conviction shouted back to the Roman guard: "I'll pay you double if you stand outside my house and ask me those two questions every morning!"

As followers of Jesus Christ, do you know who you are and what is the purpose of your life? Is your life purposeful or are you drifting aimlessly? The apostle Peter said as followers of Christ, we are given new identities and purpose. "You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called us out of darkness into his wonderful light" (1 Pet 2:9).

Paul said, "even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us" (Eph 1:4). God chose us purposely, not randomly and as children, we are given full rights (Gal 4:7). In the old covenant, only the priests can perform sacrifices and lead worship. Having sanctified and perfected us through the offering of himself (Heb 10:10-14), Jesus Christ has made all who are in Him the priesthood that God always intended His people to be. We are no longer worship observers but active worship participants. When God said "you," is he referring to a singular pronoun "you" or a plural "you"? God said, "You are to be holy to me for I am holy, and have set you apart from the nations to be my own" (Lev 20:26). "You" refers to all God's children, not just a select few.

To complement the impressive titles that God has given us, we are given an equally impressive purpose, "to declare the praises of him who called us out of darkness into his wonderful light" (1 Pet 2:9b). When we forget our identity, we may become overwhelmed with the task that God has called to do. God help us, we may even give up or become lazy or even be complacent. Therefore, before we begin each day, let us ask ourselves these two questions, who we are and what we are doing here?

HISTORY OF THE CHURCH

The Orchard Road Presbyterian Church was founded in 1856 to minister to the needs of the Scots community in Singapore. The first church building on the present site was completed in 1878, and has been extended several times, notably in 1975 when the sanctuary was extended and in 1985 when the new extension of the Dunman Hall was completed and a new chapel was built. Alongside the growth of the physical facilities has been the development of the church from an English-speaking expatriate congregation to a local church embracing four different language congregations and a new branch church at Bukit Batok (1995). In addition to the English-speaking congregation, the Indonesian congregation (1976) and the German congregation (1978) now regularly worship and minister as part of Orchard Road Presbyterian Church. In 2005, the Mandarin congregation (1968) became independent as Providence Presbyterian Church but continues to use the buildings for worship and ministry. In 2013, the branch church at Bukit Batok also became independent and is now Bukit Batok Presbyterian Church.

FAITH AND MEMBERSHIP

As a church with our roots in historic Presbyterianism growing out of the Westminster Confession of Faith, we affirm the Lordship of our Saviour, Jesus Christ. We look to the Scriptures as the inspired word of God and the one authoritative and infallible standard for our faith and practice. We welcome those who profess Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour into our formal membership. Our membership is truly international, representing the breadth of God's call upon people from all ethnic and economic backgrounds.

Members are received upon initial profession of faith in Jesus Christ by baptism, confirmation and in transfer from other Christian churches. Classes for baptism, confirmation and for transfer of membership are held periodically and announced in the bulletin.

THE APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; he descended into hell, the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven and sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead. I believe in the Holy Ghost, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the Life everlasting. AMEN
