## The Posture of Listening

What should I do with my life? Who should I date? Should I get married? Who should I marry? What course of study should I pursue? Which tertiary institution should I go to? What job should I take up? How do I know I'm making the right decisions? These are just a few of the questions we all wrestle with at some point. And in a world where all waiting time is seen as wasted time to be eliminated, we no longer have many chances to practise patience. Part of our—and subsequent—generation's challenge of faith is learning to wait on God's answer and his perfect timing, instead of bringing our concerns to him but having no patience to wait for his reply.

In the devotional classic *The Secret of Guidance*, F.B. Meyer advised that when we are praying about whether to make a certain decision, we should look for the alignment of what he called 'the three lights': God's word, the Spirit's prompting, and our life's circumstances. He wrote:

Sometimes we sigh for an angel to come to point the way but the time has not come for us to move. If you do not know what you ought to do, stand still until you do. And when the time comes for action, circumstances, like glowworms, will sparkle along your path... The circumstances of our daily life are to us an infallible indication of God's will when they concur with the inward promptings of the Spirit and with the Word of God. So long as they are stationary, wait. When you must act, they will open, and a way will be made through oceans and rivers, wastelands and rocks.

Like everyone, there are times when I intensely seek God's clear direction in life and in ministry. It is in such a context, over the past six consecutive days (at time of writing), that the passage and theme of 1 Sam 3 kept surfacing—impressing upon me to be in ready posture in order to hear God's word clearly. God spoke with Samuel, but also with all his prophets and apostles. Even today, he guides us with His Holy Spirit (*paraklētos*)—one who is present with us, an advocate and helper (John 14:16). God cares about our questions around life's questions and purposes and will direct us to do certain things or pursue certain opportunities. Let us learn to perceive what he is saying to us.

## **Bible Readings & Prayer Points**

### **Read Exodus 20:4-7**

- What do these verses reveal about God and His responses to our devotion to Him or our lack of it?
- How may these verses encourage you to seek after God?
- In what ways have you dishonoured God's name this past week? In these areas, how may you choose to honour His Name instead?

### **Prayer Points**

- Pray for our growing devotion to God. Thank Him that on account of Jesus' faithfulness, we can experience His unfailing love for us now and forever.
- Pray that we will grow as a disciple-making church to i) know God and His Word, ii) love one another, iii) develop Christlike character, iv) serve one another, and v) commit to Christ's mission.
- Pray that the study of Design for Discipleship Book 1 in our Discipleship Groups (DGs) will deepen our understanding of the Gospel to appreciate the saving works of our triune God.
- Pray that more members and worshippers will be able to benefit from our learning journey by growing together with our discipleship groups.
- Pray that God will reveal more and more of our Lord Jesus to us as a church through the preaching and teaching of His word, our fellowships, prayers, and services to Him.

## HISTORY

The Orchard Road Presbyterian Church (ORPC) was founded in 1856 to minister to the needs of the Scots community in Singapore. The first church building on the present site was completed in 1878, and has been extended several times. In 1975, the sanctuary was extended, and in 1985, the new extension of Dunman Hall was completed and a new chapel was built. Alongside the growth of the physical facilities has been the development of the church from an English-speaking expatriate congregation to a local church embracing four different language congregations. In 1995 we planted a branch church (Bukit Batok Presbyterian Church) which became independent in 2013. Similarly, our Mandarin congregation (Providence Presbyterian Church) became independent in 2005. ORPC consists of the English Congregation and the Indonesian Congregation, and worshipping with us now in the same building are Providence Presbyterian Church, and the German-speaking Protestant Congregation in Singapore.

## FAITH AND MEMBERSHIP

As a church with roots in historic Presbyterianism growing out of the Westminster Confession of Faith, we affirm the Lordship of our Saviour, Jesus Christ. We look to the Scriptures as the inspired Word of God and the one authoritative and infallible standard for our faith and practice. We welcome those who profess Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour into our formal membership. Our membership is truly international, representing the breadth of God's call upon people from all ethnic and economic backgrounds. Members are received upon initial profession of faith in Jesus Christ by baptism, confirmation, and in transfer from other Christian churches. Classes for baptism, confirmation, and for transfer of membership are held periodically and announced in the bulletin.

## THE APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the grave. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
