¹⁴ “‘Observe the Sabbath, because it is holy to you. Anyone who desecrates it is to be put to death; those who do any work on that day must be cut off from their people. ¹⁵ For six days work is to be done, but the seventh day is a day of sabbath rest, holy to the LORD. Whoever does any work on the Sabbath day is to be put to death. ¹⁶ The Israelites are to observe the Sabbath, celebrating it for the generations to come as a lasting covenant. ¹⁷ It will be a sign between me and the Israelites forever, for in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, and on the seventh day he rested and was refreshed.’”

“Can I Lose my Salvation?”

If you are worried enough to ask this question, chances are you shouldn't worry about being saved! Why? Because in our Presbyterian understanding of election, we recognize that God saves sinners who do not in themselves even want to be saved. As Paul writes, we were once dead in our transgressions and sins (Ephesians 2:1), living under the dominion of darkness (Colossians 1:13); sin had such a complete hold over us that our whole being—heart, mind, desire, and will—is utterly unresponsive to God. Asking this question indicates that God's Spirit is at work within us; otherwise, we would not care about this question, but continue in sin, unconcerned about our relationship with God.

Presbyterian theology sees the crucial role the Holy Spirit plays in salvation to be an especially important conviction. It is the Spirit who regenerates, granting spiritual life to dead sinners (John 3:5), that we may become conscious of our sinfulness and be responsive to God's gracious offer of salvation in Christ Jesus. If we believe in the gospel, we can be sure that God has chosen me to come to faith by the power of the Holy Spirit.

God's Spirit seals us for the “day of redemption” (Ephesians 4:30). There may be times when we sin, and sin grievously; there may be long periods where we drift away from Christ. If someone who previously confessed faith in Christ comes to denounce Christ, it is a sign that the profession of faith was not genuine in the first place. But we do not “backslide” to the point of losing our salvation. When our confession of Christ is genuine and we are united to Christ through faith, God's Holy Spirit abides in us so that we never totally or finally fall away from God's grace.

Moreover, those who believe are held in salvation by God's power, not our own power or determination. The apostle Paul said, “being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus” (Phil. 1:6). Jesus spoke the same assurance when he said, “I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand... no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand” (John 10:28-29). God who gives us the gift of salvation as an act of free grace is the same God who continues to hold us in that salvation. We can give great thanks for that!

Bible Readings & Prayer Points

Read Exodus 32:1–35

- Read vv.1-10. Israel, under Aaron's leadership, made a golden calf contrary to God's thoughtful instructions to Moses to build the Tabernacle. The false worship also led to their immoral indulgences. How does this underscore the need for our worship to be fully regulated by God's word alone?
- Read vv.11-14. Notice how Moses' intercession was effectively grounded on God's promises and glory. What does this teach you about prayer?
- Read vv.15-35. How was the sin of the people restrained and corrected? What does this teach you about sin and its power to destroy and deviate us from God's gracious plan for our lives?

Prayer Points

- Pray that our members will live consecrated lives as God's holy priesthood just as we were taught in the book of Exodus.
- Pray that as our Discipleship Groups embark on the Design for Discipleship Book 4 studies in July, we will grow in our character as Christ's followers.
- As we set Christ apart as Lord, pray that we will become effective witnesses for Him wherever He places us, knowing how to answer anyone who asks for a reason for the hope that is in us as 1 Peter 3:15 instructs.

HISTORY

The Orchard Road Presbyterian Church (ORPC) was founded in 1856 to minister to the needs of the Scots community in Singapore. The first church building on the present site was completed in 1878, and has been extended several times. In 1975, the sanctuary was extended, and in 1985, the new extension of Dunman Hall was completed and a new chapel was built. Alongside the growth of the physical facilities has been the development of the church from an English-speaking expatriate congregation to a local church embracing four different language congregations. In 1995 we planted a branch church (Bukit Batok Presbyterian Church) which became independent in 2013. Similarly, our Mandarin congregation (Providence Presbyterian Church) became independent in 2005. ORPC consists of the English Congregation and the Indonesian Congregation, and worshipping with us now in the same building are Providence Presbyterian Church, and the German-speaking Protestant Congregation in Singapore.

FAITH AND MEMBERSHIP

As a church with roots in historic Presbyterianism growing out of the Westminster Confession of Faith, we affirm the Lordship of our Saviour, Jesus Christ. We look to the Scriptures as the inspired Word of God and the one authoritative and infallible standard for our faith and practice. We welcome those who profess Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour into our formal membership. Our membership is truly international, representing the breadth of God's call upon people from all ethnic and economic backgrounds. Members are received upon initial profession of faith in Jesus Christ by baptism, confirmation, and in transfer from other Christian churches. Classes for baptism, confirmation, and for transfer of membership are held periodically and announced in the bulletin.

THE APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the grave. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.
