Global Concerns

• Continue to pray for peace to hold in the Middle East and for a peaceful end to the Ukraine/Russia conflict.

- Pray for the USA and the policy changes being made that they will not destabilise world order.
- Pray for Myanmar where over 1 700 people have perished and thousands are missing and trapped and not accounted for because of the massive earthquake that struck on Friday, 28 March. Surrounding countries like Thailand and Yunnan have been deeply impacted by this earthquake as well, experiencing tremours and aftershocks from this massive earthquake. Pray for God's mercy on the people there. Pray that God will make clear the path for relief and medical supplies to reach the people as swiftly as possible, as the death toll is rising. The UN estimates that the death toll can reach 10 000 and even more. Pray also for God's peace to reign in the hearts of His people and for the leaders in Myanmar to continue to allow international help in this unprecedented 'nightmare', without reservation.
- Pray for us Christians that in these times of war, violence, disasters and plagues, we will hold on to the promises that our God reigns and He is the Ruler over heaven and earth, and the seas and the skies. Nothing escapes Him. He can turn this horrendous situation around as He speaks His powerful words. Speak Lord and do Your mighty work amid your people.

Gospel Ministry to the World

- Pray for the safety and success of missionaries who work to spread the gospel.
- Pray for the Bilala in Chad. (https://www.joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/calendar)

The Bilala live in compact villages in Chad, each run by a local chief. The chief and the village elders settle disputes among villagers and deal with outsiders. A Bilala girl will live in her mother's hut until she is ready to marry. However, a boy will move out of his mother's hut as soon as he reaches puberty and is able to build his own hut. Families arrange marriages with the consent of the young people. As far as we know, all the Bilala are Muslims. There is no gospel witness. The nearby Muslim Arab merchants, with whom they trade regularly, have strongly influenced them.

- Pray that the hearts of the Bilala will be open to Christ. Pray for a family-based movement to Christ to transform Bilala society, blessing them spiritually and economically.
- Pray for the Lord to move believers to sacrifice their lives to see the Bilala blessed by Jesus Christ, the only Saviour.
- Pray for Bilala decision-makers to open their communities to Christ's ambassadors.

Singapore

Pray for Singapore's forthcoming general election, that the government elected will continue to support values, beliefs, and practices that honour God.

Prayer for the English Presbytery (EP) and the Church at Large

English Presbytery Holy Week Convention (EP HWC) – The Meaning of the Cross (16 to 18 April)

- Pray for the preparation of our hearts and minds as we await the commemoration of the death and resurrection of Christ.
