Global Concerns

• Continue to pray for the fragile peace in the Middle East, and for the Ukraine-Russia war to end.

• Pray for the USA and the abrupt policy changes that have been made that have affected individuals and countries. May wisdom and justice prevail according to God's will.

Gospel Ministry to the World

- Pray for the safety and success of missionaries who work to spread the gospel.
- Pray for the Yadav in Nepal.

The Yadav are a caste comprising milkmen, cowherds, farmers and labourers. Their traditional occupations are animal husbandry and the selling of animal products. Some of them are landlords. Some are businessmen, teachers, doctors, engineers or political leaders. Typically, Christians there try to convert Hindus there one at a time and include them in a church fellowship. The problem with this approach is that it isolates them from their family and often causes their family to equate following Christ with rebellion. It may be better to wait patiently for family elders to come to Christ first rather than pulling people out from their family. So, pray that Yadav family leaders will follow Christ, opening the way for entire families to follow suit. Pray that Christ will show Himself just, merciful and almighty to the Yadav, making them curious to want to know more about Him. Pray that Yadav believers will lead in drawing others to the foot of the cross by example. Ask God to give Yadav believers strength to weather the storm of persecution that new believers often face.

Prayer for the Church at Large

A&A Project

- Thank God for His leading of and providence for the A&A project. Thank Him for the successful conclusion of the sale of the church property at 33 Holland Grove Drive as part of the fund-raising effort for the A&A project.
