The Toukaleur Fulani people are primarily pastoralists, but in some areas, they may engage in trade.

The women in this people group often use henna around the mouth, resulting in a blackening around the lips. The traditional dress of the Fulani people in most places consists of long colourful flowing robes, modestly embroidered or otherwise decorated. The various Fulani groups have a long-standing, strong commitment to Islam. It is part of their identity. Christians need to help the Fulani people with their material and physical needs and build bridges of trust and friendship in order to be heard. Pray that the Fulani people will be able to provide adequately for their families, as they live in a harsh region. Pray for the light of Christ to reach the Fulani people. There are a few followers of Jesus in the Toukaleur Fulani community. Pray that they will be nurtured by God's Spirit and mature in their faith. Pray that radical Islam will not overtake Senegal's Fulani people.

#### Singapore

- May families, in times of stress, seek refuge in our Lord. May the Holy Spirit uplift those in despair and God's help be extended to those in need.
- Pray for those affected by vaping, that they will have wisdom and strength enough to prevent and stop this scourge from spreading.
