Prayer for the World & Singapore

Global Concerns

- Pray for Israel and the war in the Middle East to end according to God's will and timing.
- Pray for the victims of the natural disasters around the world the floods in Bali; landslides in Sabah; and super typhoon Ragasa in Hong Kong, South China, Taiwan and the Philippines. Pray especially for those who have lost their loved ones and/or livelihood as a result. Pray also for all others who have been affected.
- Pray for a peaceful resolution to the civil unrest in Indonesia and Nepal. Pray for God's protection
 on and strength for the Christian communities there. Pray that God will empower them to be
 peacemakers and use this moment for the gospel to shine brightly. Pray for God to provide for
 those affected by the unrest, including families who have lost their loved ones and/or livelihood.

Gospel Ministry to the World

- Pray for God's protection on and the fruitfulness of missionaries. May more people groups be touched by the gospel.
- Pray for the Jews in Switzerland (adapted from https://www.joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/calendar).

Jews have lived in Switzerland since the 13th century. Today, most of the Jews there live in the large cities. The many Jewish organisations and communities in Switzerland, including the Ultra-Orthodox, Orthodox, and Reformed and Liberal Jews, are united by the Swiss Federation of Jewish Communities.

Pray for this people group to experience the fullness of the Holy Spirit and the overflowing, gracious love of God. Pray that they will be willing to ponder the claims of Jesus by reading the New Testament. Pray that God will open their spiritual eyes as they read and study the Old Testament. Ask the Lord to send believers to demonstrate God's love to them.

Singapore

- Pray for families that the Holy Spirit will bind family members close to one another and to Him.
- Pray for wisdom, discernment and ability for Christians to be a channel of blessing to people around them so as to point them to God.
- Pray that God will stir up a passion for mission and evangelism in our hearts and open our spiritual eyes to the Great Commission so that we will share the gospel out of love, knowing that Jesus has commanded us to do so.
- Pray for all Christian students that they will reflect God's light and love and so win their friends over to Jesus.

A&A Project

Pray for

- A smooth transition for worshippers moving from ORPC and PPC to Suntec City for the Worship Services. Pray especially for the elderly and families with young children for their adjustment to the new environment.
- God's leading and protection of the Offsite Committee as they make final preparations for the move to and setup of the worship hall at Suntec City.
- The Technical Committee and the Multi-Disciplinary Team as they evaluate tender bids submitted by contractors for the A&A works. Pray also for wisdom as the team work on finding solutions to reduce the cost of the project.
- The A&A fund-raising efforts as we continue working on raising fund for the project.

Prayer for the Congregational Care (CC) Ministry

Pray for strength and comfort for our brothers and sisters who are ill. May God lay His healing hand on them and restore them to full health. Pray for wisdom and guidance for the doctors, nurses, and caregivers who are taking care of them. Give their doctors the insight to diagnose their illnesses accurately; wisdom to decide on the right treatments for them; and skilful hands to administer care to them. Pray that the medicines and treatments they receive will work effectively and bring them healing and relief.

Discipleship Group Ministry (DGM)

- Pray that in the coming months, God will call and raise up many DG members to help other believers know and walk with Him through the 'Design for Discipleship' book series they studied in 2024.
- All our DGs have been grouped into zones since 2024. Pray for the first Zonal Fellowships in Oct and Nov for good participation of DG members to hear what God is doing in their DG, and to know one another in the zone better during the fellowship over a meal.
- Thank God for the provision of rental spaces with accessible public transport for one of our new DFD DGs; two YA DGs; and 2 DGs with elderly members, to have their meetings in, in Oct and Nov. Thank God also for members from these DGs who have contributed to our general fund to offset the rents. Pray for the provision of spaces in 2026, especially for new DGs formed, if God wills.

Children Ministry (CM)

- Thank God for a smooth run-through at Suntec on 13 September where most teachers turned up and were familiarised with the new classrooms and the logistic procedures.
- Continue to pray for the parents partnering with teachers in nurturing their child at home with God's Word and godly living through their lifestyle.
