Gospel Ministry to the World

Pray for the Labanas in India

The term 'labana' appears to have been derived from 'lun' (salt) and 'bana' (trade). The Labanas have long been a community that transported and traded salt, but today are often farmers, livestock producers and businessmen. Most Labanas are Sikhs, but there are also Hindu and Muslim communities of Labanas in other parts of India. The Labanas are spread out all over India and speak some 18 languages. It will take separate evangelistic efforts to reach each of these language groups for Christ. Pray that many youths in this people group will discover Christian videos, recordings, music and broadcasts as they search the internet and listen to radio and watch television. Pray that they will listen and view with real understanding. The Lord is calling many to Himself from among the large Banjara community, which is closely related to the Labanas. Pray that the Labanas will be included in that call as well.

Singapore

- Pray for families who are undergoing stress and changes that our Lord will be their refuge and strength.
- Pray for youths and children during this period of exams to seek Christ always, to do their best and to leave the rest to our God who loves them.

A&A Project

- Thank God for bringing forth the 6 building contractors who submitted detailed and very
 competitive bids for the A&A works. Thank God for the clear and decisive evaluation process
 which led to the selection of a winning bidder as main contractor for the A&A project. (The full
 name of the contractor will be announced when all the formalities have been completed.) Please
 pray for the expedient execution of the contract and the safety of the workers as they work on
 this project.
