The Bonan people are considered a priority for outreach due to a probable lack of exposure to Christianity and the absence of active church planting and discipleship efforts there. Originally Mongol troops sent to their present location on the edge of Chinese territory to act as watch guards against Tibetans, they have intermarried with other peoples, forming a distinct people group who call themselves Bonan, which means "I protect you". This name refers to their long history as the soldiers and protectors of the people in the area.

There has never been a Bonan church and maybe not a single Bonan believer. Missionaries have been unable to make inroads as the Bonan people are deeply rooted in Tibetan Buddhism, and this creates resistance to outside religious ideas. They are physically and socially distant from areas with active Christian outreach. Evangelism efforts must navigate complex cultural and linguistic differences.

Prayer Focus

Pray for bold workers who are driven by the love of the Holy Spirit to go to them. Pray for the authority of Christ to bind hindering spiritual forces to lead them from darkness to light. Pray for signs and wonders to happen among them and for great breakthroughs with a rapid multiplication of disciples and house churches. Pray for innovative ideas to create access to rural areas and remove barriers. Pray for linguists and translators to begin work on the Bonan-language Scripture and gospel materials.

Singapore

Pray that

God will strengthen marriages and spousal faithfulness, protecting marriages from division, strife, and brokenness.

God will guard families from the harmful influences of social media and society.

Parents will raise their children in wisdom and love and instil good values in their children and children will honour and respect their parents.

Families will be the strong pillars for Singapore and love will be the foundation of every home.
