Global Concerns

The Domal people are part of the much larger Pashtun people. The main occupations of the Domal people are animal husbandry and agriculture. From the animals, they obtain meat, dairy products, and hides. They live in the mountains and valleys of north India in Jammu and Kashmir. They need the benefits of modern medicine as well as electricity, as many do not have access to electricity.

Prayer Focus

Pray for Jesus movements to bless extended Domal families so the gospel will spread rapidly among them. Pray for the spiritual lives of the Domal people to become fruitful as they follow Christ.
