# **Prayer for the World**

The United States of America

In Uvalde, Texas, people gathered to mourn those who were killed at Robb Elementary School on 24 May 2022. A total of 19 children and two teachers were killed when an 18-year-old gunman entered the school compound. This is the nation's deadliest school shooting since the Sandy Hook massacre in Connecticut, almost a decade ago.

# Pray for:

- God's presence to be felt in the community.
- Healing of the injured, and comfort for the grieving.
- Peace and love among the community, so that they will know they are not alone.
- An end to violence and hatred.
- Wisdom and courage on governing bodies to work on regulating gun laws and policies so that such incidents will never happen again.

# Myanmar

The Burmese are the political, economic and religious leaders of Myanmar, formerly known as Burma. The Burmese have mixed Buddhist and animistic beliefs. Their animistic beliefs inherently centre around evil spirits called nats. The Burmese spend their lives trying to appease the nats. Burmese homes often have altars for the spirits, as well as a statue of Buddha. Farmers may spend more in a year on their religion than on education, health and clothing for their families.

### Pray for:

- The few Christians in Myanmar to live a godly life, and to have the zeal to grow in Christlikeness.
- Peace in Myanmar that is tempered with justice.
- The Burmese to recognise their need for forgiveness of sin and for salvation, which are found only in Christ, and pray for more Christian workers to lead them to Him.
